

ORDINANCE NO. 310

PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIANA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

- I. That this Ordinance No. expressly repeals Ordinances Nos. 206, 213, 216, 233, 239, 259, 262, and 291.
- II. That after the passage and approval of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or organization to engage in the following activities:

Section A. Parking:

1. At any place or along any curb which is marked by yellow paint or has any other markings which would indicate a "no parking" area.
2. To park a truck larger than a pick-up truck along any paved street in the residential section of the City of Columbiana, Alabama.
3. Fruit trucks selling products to the public may park only on North Main Street, north of Carter's Lane.

Section B. Traffic:

1. Any person who drives any vehicle upon any street, highway, alley, dirt road, parking lot, or any place within the City or corporate limits of the City of Columbiana, carelessly and heedlessly in willful or wanton disregard of the rights or safety of others, or without due caution and circumspection and at a speed or in a manner so as to endanger any person or property shall be guilty of reckless driving.

2. It shall be unlawful for vehicles to make a passing maneuver in areas posted as a no passing zone.
3. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a great speed than fifty-five (55) miles per hour in the following listed zones:
 - a. On Alabama #25 (Columbiana Bypass), where posted.
4. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than forty-five (45) miles per hour in the following listed zones:
 - a. On Alabama #25 North, beginning at the intersection of said road and the City limits and extending southerly for a distance of 2.0 miles.
5. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than forty (40) miles per hour in the following listed zones:
 - a. On Shelby County #30 beginning at the intersection of said road and the City limits and extending westerly to the intersection of said road and Moore Street.
 - b. On Shelby County #28, beginning at the intersection of said road and Mt. Dixie Road and extending easterly to within 1.0 mile of the City limit.
6. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than thirty-five (35) miles per hour in the following listed zones:
 - a. On Old Alabama #25 North, beginning at the intersection of said road and Alabama #25 North (Columbiana Bypass) and extending southerly for a distance of 0.4 mile .

- b. On Old Alabama #25 North, beginning at the intersection of said road and Shelby County #37 and extending westerly for a distance of 0.1 mile.
 - c. On Alabama #70, beginning at the intersection of said road and Industrial Parkway and extending westerly to the city limits.
 - d. On Shelby County #47 South, beginning at the intersection of said road and Pitts Drive and extending southerly to the city limits.
 - e. On Shelby County #47 North, beginning at the intersection of said road and Seals Drive and extending southerly for a distance of 0.5 mile.
 - f. On Shelby County #37, beginning at the intersection of said road and Old Alabama #25 and extending southerly for a distance of 1.1 miles.
7. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than twenty-five (25) miles per hour in the following listed zones:
- a. On Alabama #25 North, beginning at the intersection of said road and West Sterrett Street and extending southerly for 0.1 mile, during the hours of 7:15 - 8:30 a.m., and 2:15 - 3:30 p.m., while school is in session.
 - b. Upon any street, alley or zone not specifically mentioned or set herein.
8. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than fifteen (15) miles per hour in the following listed zones:

- a. On Washington Street, beginning at the intersection of said road and Mildred Street and extending southerly to the intersection of said road and Pitts Drive.
- III. Any person, firm or organization found in violation of Article II, Section A of this Ordinance shall be subject to a minimum fine of \$2.00 and a maximum fine of \$10.00. Any person, firm or organization found in violation of Article II, Section B of this Ordinance shall, upon first conviction, be subject to a minimum fine of \$20.00 plus court cost; repeat offenders of Article II, Section B of this Ordinance shall be subject to a maximum fine of \$500.00 and/or a maximum imprisonment of 30 days.
- IV. This Ordinance shall become effective upon being signed by the Mayor and being published as provided by law.
- V. Each and every provision of this ordinance is hereby declared to be an independent provision and the holding of any provision hereof to be void and invalid for any reason shall not affect any other provision hereof, and it is hereby declared that the other provisions of this ordinance would have been enacted regardless of any provisions which might have been invalid.

Effective April 15, 1982

Councilman Rasco introduced the following Ordinance:

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIANA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

PARKING RULES.

Section 1. No parking places.) At any time it shall be unlawful to permit any vehicle to stand in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a policeman or traffic control device:

1. In any intersection.
2. In a crosswalk.
3. Upon any bridge or viaduct.
4. At any place where the standing of a vehicle will reduce the usable width of the roadway for moving traffic to less than eighteen feet.
5. Within fifteen feet of a fire hydrant.
6. At any place where the vehicle would block the use of a driveway.
7. Within fifty feet of the nearest rail of a railroad grade crossing.
8. On any sidewalk.
9. At any place where official signs or yellow curb markings prohibit parking.
10. For more than two consecutive hours on either side of Main Street from the old courthouse north to Carter's Lane, on either side of East College Street from Main Street to Milner Street, and on either side of West College Street from Main Street to Mill Street.

Section 5. Marked spaces.) No person shall park a vehicle other than within designated markings in areas where parking spaces are marked on the pavement. No person shall park a vehicle in more than one designated space.

Section 6. Alleys.) No person shall park a vehicle within an alley in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than ten feet of the width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, and no person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle within an alley in such a position as to block the driveway entrance to any abutting property.

Section 7. Cab stands.) No vehicle other than a licensed taxicab shall be parked in an area designated by ordinance as a cab stand.

Section 8. Parking motor vehicles on private property.) It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle on any private property without the consent of the owner of the property.

Section 9. Signs.) The chief of police or any other person authorized by the mayor and council shall cause signs to be posted in all areas where parking is limited or prohibited, indicating such limitations or prohibitions.

11. In parking spaces marked for handicapped persons when parked by persons without a mobility handicap or not using a wheelchair, provided, however, that a driver of a vehicle used in transporting such handicapped persons may park in such spaces.

Section 2. Parking at curb.) No vehicle shall be parked with the left side of such vehicle next to the curb, except on one-way streets, and it shall be unlawful to stand or park any vehicle in a street other than parallel with the curb and with the two right wheels of the vehicle within twelve inches of the regularly established curb line, except that upon those streets that have been marked for angle parking, vehicles shall be parked at the angle to the curb indicated by such marks.

Section 3. Vehicles for sale.) It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle upon any street for the purpose of displaying it for sale, or to park any vehicle upon any business street from which vehicle, merchandise is peddled.

Section 4. Loading zone.) It shall be unlawful for the driver of a vehicle to stand a passenger vehicle for a period of time longer than is necessary for the loading or unloading of passengers, not to exceed three minutes, and for the driver to stand any freight carrying vehicles for a period of time longer than is necessary to load, unload and deliver materials, not to exceed thirty minutes, in any place designated as a loading zone and marked as such.

Section 10. Penalty.) Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than two dollars nor more than ten dollars for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 11. This ordinance is cumulative and supplements existing parking regulations heretofore adopted.

Section 12. Severability.) Each and every provision of this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an independent provision and the holding of any provision hereof to be void and invalid shall not affect any other provisions of this ordinance.

Section 13. Effective date.) This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and adoption by the City Council of the City of Columbiana, Alabama.
