

**REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY OF COLUMBIANA, ALABAMA  
Tuesday, June 21, 2011**

The City Council of the City of Columbiana, Alabama met in Regular Session in the Council Chambers of Columbiana City Hall at 6:37 p.m., Tuesday, June 7, 2011. Mayor Lowe called the meeting to order and asked that the record reflect that all Council members were in attendance and declared a quorum.

**CONSENT AGENDA**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE RENEWAL OF THE BUSINESS LICENSE  
OF RHINO PROMOTIONS DBA SIGN GRAPHICS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Columbiana, Alabama, is aware that Rhino Promotions, dba Sign Graphics, having previously been in violation of Ordinance no. 04-08-01, Section 23, Qualifications of Applicants for License, and

**WHEREAS**, Rhino Promotions, dba Sign Graphics, has taken steps to remedy the issues of non-compliance;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF COLUMBIANA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That in accordance with Ordinance no. 04-08-01, Section 26, the City Council of the City of Columbiana authorizes the renewal of the business license for Rhino Promotions, dba

Sign Graphics, contingent upon notification from RDS, Revenue Discovery Systems, acting as the City's agent, that the taxpayer is fully compliant.

Council member Handley commented that Alfa is still shooting for a commercial and on their use of local vehicles and sites within the City, the downtown area, the sports complex and the co-op. Also he thanked the participants in the Clean Up day.
