**Pre-Council Meeting**

**February 15, 2011**

**MINUTES**

The members of the Columbiana City Council conducted a pre-council meeting with Mayor Lowe presiding. The meeting was held at Columbiana City Hall in the Conference Room at 6:05 p.m.

The following members were present: Frieda Abrams, Stancil Handley, Jim Strickland, Ouida Mayfield and Tom Seale.

The meeting was called to order. Mayor Lowe reviewed the agenda and the following items were discussed:

- Mayor Lowe advised that he would be going to Montgomery with Bill Palatucci, from CEC, and Mike Hill to meet with the governor to discuss adding residents at the facility to meet capacity. He also met with Rescue 88 and discussed signing a contract between them and the City.
- City Clerk Gina Antolini requested the council consider adding Resolution 02-11-04 to the agenda. The resolution denies renewal of a business license for Sign Graphics due to non-compliance with the city business license ordinance. Council member Seale moved to add the item and Council member Abrams seconded. The City Council requested she report to the council regarding sales tax at the next regular council meeting, March 1, 2011.
- Police Chief Lamar Vick reported to the council regarding some scams that are prevalent in the community and said he would be getting the word out to seniors, on the website and in the newsletter.
- City Clerk Gina Antolini updated the council on an initiated audit for a delinquent taxpayer.
- Mayor Lowe advised of the Greater Shelby County Chamber Mayors luncheon on February 23, Focus on Columbiana at the South Shelby Chamber luncheon on March 3.
- Mayor Lowe discussed the potential of a reduced business licensee fee for a business incubation center.
