Pre-Council Meeting

March 15, 2011

MINUTES

The members of the Columbiana City Council conducted a pre-council meeting with Mayor Lowe presiding. The meeting was held at Columbiana City Hall in the Conference Room at 6:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Frieda Abrams, Stancil Handley, Jim Strickland, Ouida Mayfield and Tom Seale.

The following members were absent: None

The meeting was called to order. Mayor Lowe reviewed the agenda and the following items were discussed:

- Discussion of sidewalk work-regarding Depot Street, from Main Street to the Bypass (estimated at \$54,000) and the Cemetery loop (\$12,000).
- Mayor Lowe advised that the Latter Day Saints would be working with other area churches to spruce up the Columbiana City cemetery on April 30, 2011. There will be a meeting with the Mayor and Mr. King on Monday, March 21st at 3:00 p.m. to discuss the project.
- Question was presented whether or not the Adopt-a-Mile Sign on Hwy 47 South near the cemetery could be moved (Alabama Farmers Federation).
- Council member Handley advised that Randy Glenn was planning to resume the Farmer's Market around 4/16. Questions regarding the ability to set up 10 x 30 tents-and leave them up for a week; placing produce signs on the day of the Farmer's Market; a permanent banner.
- Council member Strickland regarding the golf course-as follow up. Talked with Tim Wilson and the nets are drooping and not quite doing the intended job. Tim is working on correcting that and with the residents at Magnolia Parc. He has re-aligned the tee box also.
