MINUTES

The members of the Columbiana City Council conducted a pre-council meeting with Mayor Lowe presiding. The meeting was held at Columbiana City Hall in the Conference Room at 6:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Frieda Abrams, Stancil Handley, Jim Strickland Tom Seale and Ouida Mayfield.

The following members were absent: None.

The meeting was called to order. Mayor Lowe reviewed the agenda and the following items were discussed:

- Library Director Jane Bailey reported that she had hired former employees, Teresa Morton and Joyce Saxon, to work on a part-time as needed basis and new employees, Mary Young and Judy Knotts, pending background investigation.
- Public Works Director Hilry King discussed the process regarding the Municipal Water Pollution Prevention program and stated that the full report is available to the council if they want to review it, as it is a lengthy document.
- Mayor Lowe advised that Fire Chief Johnny Howard, Jr. is at awards night at the SCHS and was unable to be at the meeting.
- Council member Mayfield asked about the pending delinquent business license issue and City Clerk Antolini responded with an update.
- Mayor Lowe reported that Ordinance Enforcement Officer Lisa Lively has issued 31 business licenses this year in conjunction with her duties, resulting in approximately \$3,500.00, bringing the three year total to \$14,365 of revenue generated.

- Department head reports were given by the City Clerk, Police Chief, Library Director and Public Works Director.
