MINUTES

The members of the Columbiana City Council conducted a pre-council meeting with Mayor Pro Tem Seale presiding. The meeting was held at Columbiana City Hall in the Conference Room at 6:00 p.m.

The following members were present:

Frieda Abrams, Stancil Handley and Ouida Mayfield.

The following members were absent: Jim Strickland and Mayor Lowe.

The meeting was called to order. Mayor Pro Tem Seale reviewed the agenda and the following items were discussed:

- Request that council packets be in the council members' mailboxes by the end of business on Friday before the council meeting to allow for adequate review of items.
- Police Chief Vick advised that Sergeant Lilly has organized a Trick or Treat for Saturday, October 30, from 4:00-6:00 p.m. for ages 6-10, to educate the children on Halloween safety. The trick or treat will occur on Mildred Street.
- Fire Chief Howard re-iterated the "no-burn" issued by the State Fire Marshall's office.
- City Clerk Antolini advised that the audit was scheduled to begin on October 25, 2010.
- Council member Handley advised he received a phone call from Benny Davis regarding trailers on Depot Street and discussion of the disposition, as he has been requested to remove them by the City.
- Council member Mayfield asked about the parking lot behind the former Health Department, regarding potential additional parking.
- Discussion regarding the status of the striping bid for various parking areas resulted in the need to check with Public Works Director King for an update.
