MINUTES

The members of the Columbiana City Council conducted a pre-council meeting with Mayor Pro Tem Seale presiding. The meeting was held at Columbiana City Hall in the Conference Room at 6:00 p.m.

The following members were present:

Frieda Abrams, Jim Strickland and Ouida Mayfield.

The following members were absent: Stencil Handley and Mayor Lowe.

The meeting was called to order. Mayor Pro Tem Seale reviewed the agenda and the following items were discussed:

- Allen Reynolds addressed the Council regarding Christmas lights and the need to replace some of the lights on Main Street. The approximate cost will be \$1,500-2,000. The Council directed him to proceed with the replacement from the Old Courthouse to the Reporter.
- Public Works Director Hilry King recommends striping the streets (handicap and cross-walks included) and the money is included in his budget. The Council was in agreement that he proceed with the striping.
- Resolution 10-10-05 was removed from the agenda since the subject matter was relative to the election and it was considered to be unnecessary.
