The members of the Columbiana City Council conducted a pre-council meeting with Mayor Lowe presiding. The meeting was held at Columbiana City Hall in the Conference Room at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Lowe reviewed the agenda and the following items were discussed:

- Randy Glenn contacted the mayor regarding the upcoming year relative to the Farmers Market and the Spring Yard Sale.
- Item #7-Resolution 12-11-05 Agreement for Re-Districting Services was removed from the agenda and City Clerk Gina Antolini was charged with contacting the City Attorney to review a portion of the agreement.
- Item #8-Resolution 12-11-06 Shelby County Reporter Advertising Agreement was removed from the agenda. The Council deemed it was within the Mayor's duties to determine the advertising priorities for the City and since the expenditure was within the approved budget, no further Council action was needed.
- Mayor Lowe reported on Public Works Director Hilry King's status and advised he would take Department Head reports in Council meeting.
- Council member Mayfield advised that Josh Holland would be at the meeting and he had approached her regarding a street light on Pine Hill Circle. Discussion regarding the cost.
- Change order on the Main Street Sidewalk project-question regarding the need for the new poles to remain hot 24/7. Mayor Lowe will advise Gresham, Smith and Partners to resubmit the change order, if necessary, without the additional circuit.
