MINUTES

The members of the Columbiana City Council conducted a pre-council meeting with Mayor Lowe presiding. The meeting was held at Columbiana City Hall in the Conference Room at 6:05 p.m.

The following members were present: Frieda Abrams, Stancil Handley, Jim Strickland, Tom Seale, Ouida Mayfield

The following members were absent: None

The meeting was called to order. Mayor Lowe reviewed the agenda and the following items were discussed:

- Randy Glenn sent a letter to the Mayor regarding the Farmer's Market. Mayor Lowe reviewed the highlights of the letter, indicating the successes of the Farmer's Market and that Randy was looking forward to the next year. Council member Handley requested the City recognize Randy for his efforts and dedication.
- Mayor Lowe reported that Doug Davis had expressed interest in removing the metal on the Summer Classics property at no charge to the City. Discussion of the details and the future potential use of the site ensued.
- Mayor Lowe discussed the extension of the millage for school tax and what options were available if the vote failed.
- Mayor Lowe presented the council with a request for a one-time pay increase for city employees. City Clerk Gina Antolini distributed the proposed resolution, 12-10-02 which would grant a one-time pay increase to all qualified employees of \$100.00. Questions regarding the funding and how the increase would be applied were addressed to the City Clerk and Mayor. Council member Mayfield moved to add Resolution 12-10-02 Amending the 2011 Fiscal Year Budget to include a One-time Pay Increase, to the agenda for consideration and Council member Abrams seconded and it was added as item number five (5).

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 6:34 P.M.
