**RESOLUTION 12-13-04**

**REDIRECTION OF PAVING FUNDS FOR MEYER STREET PAVING PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Columbiana has been desirous of resurfacing Meyer Street in the City of Columbiana, and

**WHEREAS**, the Shelby County Highway Department agreed to include the paving of Meyer Street in their 2013 paving program, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has approved funding paving projects within the city for the FY 2014 City Budget and authorizes the redirection of a portion of the \$14,000.00 paving funds from Reed Drive to cover said \$12,450.19 expenditure for Meyer Street with funding provided by the following account:


Capital Expense Account                      \$12,450.19

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIANA, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:**

The Mayor of the City of Columbiana is hereby authorized and directed to submit to Shelby County the required payment for the inclusion of this street in the Shelby County 2013 paving contract; and that the City Clerk be authorized to transfer the amount to the Capital Expense account as indicated above out of the General Fund Account.

**THEREUPON** Council member Whiting moved and Council member King seconded the motion that said resolution be given vote, and said resolution passed by majority vote of all members of the Council.
