DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

- **Library** - Tom Rary reported that he is preparing to launch the Adult Fall Reading Program. For each 3 books that are checked out, the participant will receive an entry into the drawing. There will be 2 gift cards to Tin Top, 2 gift cards to Piggly Wiggly and 2 for the Chevron. The 28th of this month is the final movie night. There are many activities coming up with school just around the corner.
- **Administration** – City Clerk Mark Frey reported that the City election is over and the Mayor and all Council members have run unopposed. He has been preparing all of the documentation required to certify the election results tonight. Mark stated that he hasn't found where this has ever happened before in Columbiana and congratulated the Mayor and Council.
- **Streets and Maintenance** – Allen Reynolds said he and the guys have been busy cutting grass and picking up brush. He has a price for the triple slide that has been damaged at the park. The cost is approximately \$3,500. The Council asked City Clerk Frey to prepare a resolution for the purchase of this slide. The Mayor asked Allen to work towards finding a solution for the graffiti that is located on this equipment. The Mayor also read 2 letters of appreciation for Allen's crew during recent events.
- **Environmental Services** – Dale Lucas reported that he and Chris Lee participated on a team for the Shelby County Shindig. He has had to bring in 10K gallons of bacteria due to an unknown problem at the sewer plant. Something came into the plant and killed many of the good bacteria but they are unable to discover where it came from due to the delay in receiving test results.

Everything went well on the Hwy 25 Bypass pump station rehab. This new setup is much better than what was replaced. Highland Drive continues to require work due to the way that the sewer main was installed.

- **Rescue** – Matt Rush reported that they had received a \$194,000 FEMA grant for new equipment for Rescue. 4 Life Pack Monitors and 4 CPR Assist devices. These are approximately a 95% grant with only about a \$10,000 local match coming from Rescue.
- **Police Department** – Chief Lamar Vick reported that things are going good with the PD. There have been many individuals, churches and other groups who have come by to bring food and show appreciation for the Police Department. This has been welcomed considering the climate in many other cities across the country. The officers have really been touched at the outpouring from our community.
- **Fire Department** – Chief Johnny Howard Jr. reported that three of their front line trucks went down at the same time. All are back on line except for the new truck. They were covered by automatic aid from surrounding departments. The Shindig went well and the fire department set up cooling stations. Most of the calls in recent weeks have been for trees or limbs down.

Highland drive has several trees that are overhanging power lines. The Mayor will reach out to Alabama Power to see if they can help us.

MARKETING

Elizabeth reported that on August 2-4 there will be a resource team that comes into town for the Main Street Alabama project. There are 2 more weeks of Music on Main and everyone is invited to come out.
