MINUTES

The members of the Columbiana City Council conducted a council work session with Mayor Handley presiding. The meeting was held at Columbiana City Hall in the Conference Room.

The following members were present:

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. The proposals for support of the South Shelby Chamber of Commerce and the Greater Shelby Chamber of Commerce were discussed. The proposed amendment of FY 2013 budget was discussed and reviewed by the council.

The council also discussed the project on Old Hwy 25 West, an ATRIP project that would cost approximately \$200,000 and would require a city match of \$40,000.

The council discussed the ordinance governing garbage and sewer rates and the clerk will research and report back to the council at a future council meeting.

The mayor reported on the resurrection of a city newsletter and discussed the content and design. It will be printed by the Reporter and they will receive the advertisement revenue but there will be no cost assessed to the city from the Reporter. The only associated cost would be to display it in the local businesses (racks, etc.).

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 10:45 p.m.
