**RESOLUTION 03-13-07 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING  
THE PURCHASE OF A TRUCK**

Council member Whiting introduced Resolution 03-13-07, Declaring an Emergency and Authorizing the Purchase of a Truck, and moved that all rules governing the council, which might unless suspended, prevent the passage and adoption of said resolution at this meeting, be and the same are hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the said resolution to be finally passed and adopted at this meeting. Council member King seconded the motion. The mayor called for a voice vote. The results were as follows:

**RESOLUTION 03-13-07**

**DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A  
TRUCK**

**WHEREAS**, the Columbiana City Council recognizes that due to mechanical failure of the city's dump trucks, and

**WHEREAS**, the Columbiana City Council had previously identified the need to purchase a truck and included it in the capital budget and recognizes the requirement to adhere to the state bid law, and

**WHEREAS**, the City realizes that without a truck, utilized for removing garbage and maintaining a safe environment in the City, that there is a potential health hazard to the residents of the City, and

**WHEREAS**, the hardship the absence of the truck would create on the normal operation of the City necessitates immediate action.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Columbiana that the City Council hereby declares an emergency due to the mechanical failure of two trucks and the resulting impact on City operations and authorizes the purchase of a one ton truck not to exceed \$24,500 with the funds to be paid from the Capital Expense account and authorizes the City Clerk/Treasurer to transfer the funds to the Capital Expense account and to update the FY2013 budget.

Council member Mayfield moved that said resolution, Resolution 03-13-07, Declaring an Emergency and Authorizing the Purchase of a Truck, be finally passed and adopted as introduced. Council member King seconded the motion. Mayor Handley put the question of final passage and the adoption of said resolution to vote of the council and on call of the roll the results were as follows:
