AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO SIGN AGREEMENT WITH BIRMINGHAM REGIONAL PARATRANSIT CONSORTIUM DBA CLASTRAN FOR ADMINISTERING 5311 FEDERAL GRANT ALLOCATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Columbiana is desirous of continuing a mutually beneficial agreement with the BRPC dba ClasTran in order to participate in the 5311 Federal Grant Program to be used as 50% Funding (less 20% match) for the City’s Trolley Service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbiana is desirous of continuing a mutually beneficial lease agreement of the 2014 StarCraft City Van to BRPC dba ClasTran in order to provide accessible rural transportation for Columbiana’s citizens.




