Since there are confirmed cases of the COVID-19 virus in Montgomery and in Jefferson counties Governor Ivy has proclaimed a state of emergency.

As a result, the City of Columbiana is taking the following precautionary measures for the safety and health of Columbiana residents:

- Our spring sports will be delayed until the end of March. All organized Park and Recreation activities have ceased, and Park and Recreation leaders will reevaluate at the end of March
- The Columbiana Library will remain open for now but will be reevaluated daily
- The Senior Center scheduled trips have been cancelled and will be rescheduled. The Senior Center will remain open. Adjustments for the Senior Centers daily operation will be made if the risk escalates
- City Hall, Public Works and Environmental Service offices will continue to operate within normal business hours. City employees will be available to serve our citizens in all areas.
- Police and Fire will maintain their regular protection for our Columbiana citizens
- City Council meetings will continue on the first and third Tuesdays at 6pm

We will remain aware of all concerns and the progression of COVID-19 as we continue to serve our citizens.
