**Discussion – Old Public Works Building**

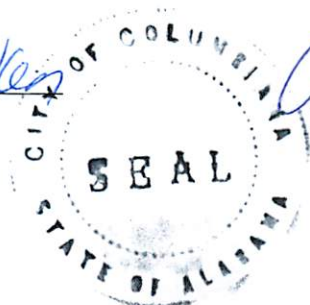
Council discussed the need to tear down the old Public Works building and pave the area for parking at Old Mill Square. Council will be updated when more information is received.
